Driving Directions to Mt. Spokane

From Spokane:

Go North on Highway 2. Turn Right onto E. Mt. Spokane Park Dr/WA-206. Continue through the roundabout to stay on E. Mt Spokane Dr/WA-206. Continue onto N. Mt Spokane Park Dr/WA-206. This road takes you up Mt. Spokane. Turn Right onto N. Summit Rd. Take your first Right into the parking lot.

From Spokane Valley I-90:

Take the Sullivan Rd. exit (291B). Keep right to take Indiana/Sullivan Rd Northbound. Turn Left onto E. Indiana Ave. Take the first Right onto Sullivan Ave. Turn Left onto E. Wellesley Ave. Take the first Right onto N. Progress Rd. Turn Right onto N. Forker Rd. Turn Left to stay on N. Forker Rd. Turn Right onto N. Mt. Spokane Park Dr/WA-206. Continue to follow this road up most of the mountain. Turn Right onto N. Summit Rd. Take your first Right into the parking lot.

*If meeting at the Mountain instead of our Spokane Warehouse, you will need a Discover pass for parking alongside the road.

*If parking in the parking lot, you will need a one-day Sno-Park permit in addition to a Discover Pass
